On December 2nd, the Board voted in favor of the following:

BSA will support the 4 submitted symposia at Botany 2023 for \$2250 each, for a total of \$11,000.

An extra \$1000 will be provided for Symposium, *From theory to practice: new innovations and their application in conservation biology*. Submitted by: Christopher Krieg and EIC Brianna Gross. This brings the funding from BSA for this Symposium up to \$3000.

BSA is funding this symposium at a higher level as this marks the 10-year anniversary of the BSA publication *Applications in Plant Sciences* (APPS) and is co-organized with our Editor-in-Chief Brianna Gross. The plan for this symposium is to bring conservation-oriented scientists from a variety of disciplines together to share new tools and techniques with the community. This symposium can be viewed as a Celebration of the 50th Anniversary of the Endangered Species Act!
