- Collaboration and cooperation
 - Broader reach outside of our membership- new partnership
 - Entice paleobotanists or ecologists who don't attend BSA meetings or any other Society
 - collaboratively share knowledge with the American Public Gardens Association / The Society for the Preservation of Natural History Collections / American Geophysical Union (AGU)
- Publications
 - AJB/APPS topics- special journal topic
 - in addition to one-time issue, have a section on climate change in each issue
