Search for New Editor-in-Chief, Applications in Plant Sciences Journal

As you may have heard, Theresa Culley will be stepping down as Editor-in-Chief of APPS (*Applications in Plant Sciences*) after this year (and after ten years of service to the journal as its founding EIC!). The BSA Publications team is therefore starting the process of searching for a new EIC for APPS.

Below is a tentative timeline for the search (though finalizing the specific dates and deadlines would be on the agenda for our first committee meeting).

Proposed search timeline:

Step 1a: Invite people to serve on the search committee.

Step 1b: Draft a call for nominations/applications.

 Heather Cacanindin, Beth Parada, and Amy McPherson are working on this, and the draft will be shared with the committee prior to our first meeting.

Step 2: Meet with the committee via Zoom to discuss search criteria, evaluation rubric, and a timeline.

Ideally we will meet the week of Sept. 13.

Step 3: Send out the call for nominations and also ask members of the committee to encourage specific people to apply.

• Ideally we will send out the call a week or so after the first committee meeting (i.e., by the end of September).

Step 4: Meet with the committee to discuss the nominations/applications

We would thinking of aiming for a deadline sometime in October, if that seems reasonable?

Step 5: Conduct interviews via Zoom as necessary.

• Interviews would take place late October into November.

Step 6: Extend an offer.

• Ideally by the end of this calendar year!
