What is Possible and the Challenges

- We have been exploring various venues for a Virtual Conference
- Time is short to find and implement a solution in 3 months:
 - There are various solutions coming to the market quickly, but no history.
 - We would need to select a solution, and complete contractual issues.
 - The technology would be new to everyone involved.
 - Potential firms know generic conferences, but not a Botany Conference.
 - Would need to "sell" the event to our membership.
 - We would need to configure the solution to our types of events.
 - Than we need to encourage everyone to register for the event.
 - We normally start that process February 1st!

- We need technical assistance to accelerate the process.

Here is the Proposal for a Virtual Conference

Propose to have the live event online July 27 – August 1 to include:

- Special Lectures,
- Symposia,
- Colloquia
- Meet-ups and special meetings. (AJB, APPS, Board Meetings etc.)
- Birds of a feather sessions etc.
- Poster sessions
- Exhibitor opportunities

- A Master calendar view shows all the events during the conference.
- Each event would be a "session":
 - Session has an organizer, date & time.
 - Full description of the event.
 - Each session can show either a pre-recorded event or real-time viewing.
 - Participants can dial in via phone or video including Zoom.
 - Can view recorded information up to one year later.
 - Presenter can be available to chat when requested.
 - Chats are facilitated by Zoom and cell phone texting.
- Meetings would occur just like a "Session"
- Sorry, Conference Luncheons and Dinners not included 😊

Posters and Exhibitors

Exhibitors

- Numerous options available
- Can be a "sponsor" of the overall website where attendees can easily see their products

Poster Sessions

- Similar to the "session"
- Specific date & time
- Poster would be posted to the session description.
- Video and audio capabilities link poster presenter with session attendees.
- Includes chat capability.

- Abstract submission deadline May 18
- Program Directors have sessions organized by June 15
- Import abstracts into Pathable by June 22
- Email to presenters with uploading presentation instructions June 22
- All pre-recorded presentations/posters to be up-loaded by July 15
- On-line PDF schedule of presentations emailed to all registered by July 20 can sell advertising to exhibitors in the "Program book"
